

Hautapu School Year 6 and Year 7/8 Netball 2018

If your child is interested in playing netball this season, please take note of the information below.

We will be having a muster to get an indication of players on Thursday 22nd March in the hall at 3pm. Here you can pay subs and register and also ask any questions regarding the upcoming season. We will have computers and iPads available for you to use when registering.

If you are unable to attend the muster please read the following before registering your child at the Kindo Shop.

This year we are asking that payments are completed at the Kindo Shop at the time of registering. This can either be done in full with an early bird reduced rate or as a deposit with two-part payments due in Term Two.

Early bird registration fee \$ 45 To be paid by 31st March

Instalment Payments \$ 50 \$20 deposit to be paid by 31st March

2 following payments of \$15 by 16th and 30th April

Uniforms will not be issued unless full payment is received.

YEAR 6 and Year 7/8 NETBALL

Netball for year 6, 7 & 8 players will be starting on Saturday May 13th 2018. (Week one Term two). Games are played on Saturdays late mornings & afternoons at the Cambridge Netball Centre, Scott St, Leamington. The earliest game will be 11.10am the latest 2.30pm (could be 3.20pm)

The season will finish with Semi finals on 8th September and Finals on 15th September. All teams will play on both of these days. There will be no netball on the weekend of Queen's birthday (2nd June) or during the holidays (7th, 14th and 21st July). There will be grading games which will be confirmed once they know how many teams there are.

Players must wear sneakers/netball appropriate footwear.

*We are looking for volunteers interested in coaching, managing or umpiring our teams. Without these important people teams cannot operate. If you, or anyone you know is interested in supporting our teams in this way please indicate this, with your contact details, on the registration form. **Teams that do not have a coach, manager and umpire may not be registered and therefore be unable to play this season.***

*This season **Umpires will not umpire their own team**, instead will umpire a game in another round to when your team plays. This could be before or after. The umpire draw will be circulated every week. Umpires could be a family friend, teenager, aunty . . . not necessarily immediate family.*

All umpires are expected to attend an umpire theory set of classes, and by attending you receive a whistle and netball rule book. If you would like to learn to umpire or simply would like a refresher, please let me know via email barrs@hautapu.school.co.nz and I can give you the appropriate information.

Schools will still need to do a duty at least once throughout the season the things you need to do on duty may differ from previous years. An updated duty list will be on the website and emailed to all schools before the season starts. The duty teams will be on the draw each week.
